



Frost Bite Series - Supplemental Sailing Instructions, SSI

1. The series is governed by the RAYC Sailing Instructions and these Supplemental Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict, these SSI prevail.
2. The VHF radio channel to be used is Channel 37, the reserve is Channel 72.
3. Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - (a) Rule 44.1 is changed so as to read that a Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.
4. Schedule of races will be 2 races back-to-back (see SI item 5) each day. There will be 8 races scheduled over the first 4 Saturdays in October; 7th, 14th, 21st and 28th. The start times will alternate morning and afternoon to make best use of high water (see RAYC Race Schedule).
5. The Race Committee may announce the sail number of the OCS boats over the VHF as soon as possible. Not hearing the hail, the order in which the hails are made, or the Race Committee failing to make the call over the Radio will not be grounds for requesting redress (amends RRS 62.1 (a)).
6. Scoring system will be as follows:
 - (a) Three races are required to constitute a series.
 - (b) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (c) When from five to six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (d) When seven or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
